

RECREATION AREA RULES AMENDED, NOVEMBER 2021

In accordance with Maui County's latest update of Public Health Emergency Rules, which repealed the Emergency Rules promulgated June 15, 2021, and became effective September 15, 2021, we have updated our rules for the Recreation Area.

We realize that these rules are more restrictive than the last iteration. As you probably know, businesses and public spaces are faced with a difficult situation in an effort to support public health. The simplest option we have is to close down the Pool and Recreation Area but we are hopeful that residents of our community will voluntarily comply with these rules and allow us to all enjoy our facilities as best we can in these difficult times.

The following rules are in effect until officially revised:

1. Physical distancing of six feet is required throughout the area.
2. Use of any portion of the area is requested to be limited to no more than one hour.
3. A maximum of 10 persons is allowed in the lounge at any given time. Masks are required except when actively eating or drinking as described in Exhibit A(2)(b)*. Physical distancing is required.
4. A maximum of 6 persons is allowed in the pool at any given time.
5. Use of the fitness center is limited to 1 person at a time. Full vaccination for all persons 12 years and older, proof of a negative COVID test or of a previous COVID-19 infection within the last 90 days as described in Exhibit A(10)** is required. The reservation system remains in place utilizing the white board sign up process. Walk in use can take place when there are unused times.
6. Use of the BBQs is limited to a single grill for physical distancing requirements.
7. Furniture may not be moved from designated positions.
8. Showers are available for use by 1 person at a time.
